

Forest Management Certification Reassessment of Lenderskiy Iespromkhoz PJSC in Republic of Karelia, Russia 02/05/2017

Introduction - NEPCon is conducting forest management and chain of custody certification reassessment of the **Lenderskiy Iespromkhoz PJSC** located in Republic of Karelia, Russia. The assessment will be implemented from 05/06/2017 to 09/06/2017.

Scope of the Certification Assessment – The forest management certification assessment will assess the environmental, silvicultural and socioeconomic aspects of the forests managed by **Lenderskiy Iespromkhoz PJSC**, using the standard FSC-STD-RUS-V6-1-2012 Russia Natural and Plantations EN. To obtain a copy of the applicable guidelines or to make comments about these standards, please contact NEPCon by telephone, email or website listed below. NEPCon is accredited by FSC and this assessment process must follow procedures which have been approved.

Assessment Team Composition – The assessment team will be led by Alexey Tyusov (Tver, Russia). The team members will be named later.

Assessment Steps and Schedule – Following is a short description of the certification process and a tentative agenda:

- ◆ Assessment organization – NEPCon team will assemble in Petrozavodsk on 05/06/2017.
- ◆ Field assessments – The team will visit the forest management units from 05/06/2017 to 09/06/2017.
- ◆ Stakeholder consultation – Throughout the fieldwork, the team will contact local stakeholders regarding forest management in villages surrounding the forest area. This will include private interviews and discussions, and public stakeholder meetings.
- ◆ Final assessment briefing – Prior to departure the team will meet with **Lenderskiy Iespromkhoz PJSC** managers and other parties to finalize their data collection and present preliminary findings.
- ◆ Draft report production – The assessment team will produce a confidential draft report that will be circulated for comment to **Lenderskiy Iespromkhoz PJSC**. This should occur within 30 days after completion of the assessment.
- ◆ Certification decision – Upon receipt of comments on the draft report from **Lenderskiy Iespromkhoz PJSC** forest managers, and other general stakeholder comments, NEPCon will reach a certification decision. Barring unforeseen obstacles, this should occur by beginning of the September, 2017.

Your Input Sought – As a part of the forest certification assessment process we invite stakeholders to offer comment and feedback on forest management in relation to conformance with the requirements of the forest management standard referenced above as well as comments on the FME's management and protection of High Conservation Values within the forest under evaluation. We welcome input, either public or confidential, in whatever form is easiest and most secure for you. Your input will be valuable at any stage of the assessment process, but we would prefer to receive your comments either prior to the assessment, during the assessment, or prior to 15/07/2017 so that we can take them into consideration in reaching a certification decision beginning of the September, 2017. Your options for communicating your observations to us are as follows.

1. Meet with a NEPCon assessment team member during or shortly after the fieldwork.
2. Call and give comments to Alexey Tyusov NEPCon staff person responsible for coordinating this certification assessment from NEPCon Russia. If Alexey Tyusov is not in the office, please give your comments to Roman Verin.
3. Submit written comments by email to Roman Verin. Unless you request otherwise, these comments will be kept confidential and are solely for the purposes of assessing the **Lenderskiy Iespromkhoz PJSC**.

The source of any information provided will be kept confidential available to only to FSC and NEPCon staff.
