Steps and Schedule

Following is a short description of the evaluation process and a tentative agenda:

• <u>Field visits</u> - The on-site portion of the evaluation, including field visits of recent and active forest management operations, will be conducted during the week of December 2, 2019.

• <u>Stakeholder consultation</u> – Throughout the fieldwork, the team will contact local stakeholders regarding the forest management activities of Alberta-Pacific Forest Industries Inc. (Al-Pac) in communities surrounding the forest area. This can include private interviews and discussions as well as public meetings.

- <u>Final evaluation briefing</u> Prior to departure the team will meet with the Alberta-Pacific Forest Industries Inc. (Al-Pac) managers and other parties to finalize their data collection and present preliminary findings.
- <u>Draft report production</u> The audit team will produce a confidential draft report that will be circulated for comment to the Alberta-Pacific Forest Industries Inc. (Al-Pac). This should occur within one month after completion of the evaluation.
- <u>Certification decision</u> Upon receipt of comments on the draft report from the Alberta-Pacific Forest Industries Inc. (Al-Pac) forest managers, and other general stakeholder comments, NEPCon will reach a certification decision.

Your Comments Sought

As a part of the audit process we invite stakeholders to offer comment and feedback on the Alberta-Pacific Forest Industries Inc. (Al-Pac) forest management activities in relation to conformance with the requirements of the forest management standard referenced above. We welcome input, either public or confidential, in whatever form is easiest and most secure for you. Your input will be valuable at any stage of the process, but we would prefer to receive your comments either prior or during the on-site audit so that we can take them into consideration in reaching a certification decision.
