#### Introduction

Preferred by Nature is conducting an FSC<sup>®</sup> forest management reassessment audit of GreenFirst Forest Products Inc - Gordon Cosens Forest located in Kapuskasing, Ontario, Canada. The evaluation will be conducted **mid January 2023**.

#### Scope of Evaluation

The FSC<sup>®</sup> certification audit will assess the environmental, silvicultural, and socioeconomic aspects of the forest management unit(s) managed by GreenFirst Forest Products Inc - Gordon Cosens Forest using the FSC National Forest Stewardship Standard of Canada (2018). #### Team Composition

Mylène Raimbault, Ing.f. will lead the 3-person audit team which also consists of Mark Leschishin, R.P.F. and Yves Bouthillier, (Biol.M. Sc.).

## Steps and Schedule

Following is a short description of the evaluation process and a tentative agenda:

- <u>Stakeholder and Indigenous communities/peoples' consultation</u> Before and during the fieldwork, the team will contact local stakeholders and Indigenous communities/peoples regarding the forest management activities of the certificate holder in communities. This can include private interviews and discussions as well as public meetings.
- <u>Fieldwork</u> The on-site portion of the evaluation, including field visits of recent and active forest management operations, will be conducted during **mid-January 2023**.
- <u>Final evaluation briefing</u> Prior to departure the team will meet with managers and other parties to finalize their data collection and present preliminary findings.
- <u>Draft report production</u> The audit team will produce a confidential draft report that will be circulated for comment to the certificate holder. This should occur within one month after completion of the evaluation.
- <u>Certification decision</u> Upon receipt of comments on the draft report from the certificate holder forest managers, and other general stakeholder and Indigenous communities/peoples' comments, Preferred by Nature will reach a certification decision. Barring unforeseen obstacles, this should occur by **March 2023**.

### Your Comments Sought

As a part of the audit process, we invite stakeholders and Indigenous communities/peoples to offer comments on the certificate holder's forest management activities in relation to conformance with the requirements of the forest management standard referenced above. **We welcome input, either public or confidential**. Your input will be valuable at any stage of the process, but we would prefer to receive your comments before the end of the on-site audit so that we can take them into consideration in reaching a certification decision. Your options for communicating your comments are as follows:

- 1. Speak with a Preferred by Nature audit team member before or during the audit.
- 2. Send comments to the Preferred by Nature staff person responsible for coordinating this audit (see contact info below)
