



Explore pathways for incorporating the Hummingbird Seal into final products reaching end users

Organisations certified against the Sustainability Framework Standard can communicate their compliance and utilise the Seal for both segregation marking and business-to-business communication. This includes displaying it on websites and promotional materials. However, if you plan to showcase the Seal in relation to final products reaching the end consumers, **additional requirements must be fulfilled**. To utilise the Preferred by Nature Seal in relation to **final products**, organisations must achieve the **following**:



Conditions for Hummingbird Seal and claims use





Organisations certified under relevant Sustainability Framework indicators may make **claims**. If already certified under Forest Stewardship Council[™] (FSC[™]) Forest Management/Rainforest Alliance Sustainable Agriculture Standards, certification against **add-ons** (subsets of Sustainability Framework indicators) is available.



If organisations certified against relevant indicators of the Sustainability Framework Standard meet **additional criteria** (conditions 2 & 3 on previous page), they can feature the Seal in relation to **final products** reaching end consumers.



Organisations certified under the Regulatory Scope of the Sustainability Framework, tailored for international regulations like the **EU Deforestation Regulation**, are ineligible to use the Seal.
